

ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT FOR SWYNNERTON PARISH COUNCIL

This website is run by Swynnerton Parish Council. We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website, and we are always working to make our website as accessible and usable as possible.

For example, that means you should be able to:

- change colours, contrast levels and fonts
- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader

We have also tried to make the website text easy to understand.

It is possible to navigate this website by use of the keyboard; tab and arrow keys.

Most documents and pages on this website can be accessed by the use of a text to speech extension or plug in.
